Managed Funds Association¹ (“MFA”) has reviewed the NYSE MKT LLC’s (the “Exchange”) Notice of Filing and Immediate Effectiveness of Proposed Rule Change Proposes to Amend Rule 1000 – Equities to Revise the Manner by which the Exchange will Phase Out the Functionality Associated with Liquidity Replenishment Points in Connection with the Implementation of the Limit Up – Limit Down Plan² (“Proposed Rule Change”) to the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “Commission”). MFA supports the Exchange’s Proposed Rule Change to revise the manner by which the LRP functionality is phased out. We believe it makes sense to coordinate the LRP functionality phase-out with the implementation of the Limit Up – Limit Down Plan and that such coordination will help ensure a smoother transition.
